This Public Compliance Statement has been formally discussed and adopted at a meeting of the Board of Directors, on 9th October 2017.

- ensures that fundraising staff and any volunteers are provided with information and training on the Guidelines and its implementation.
- records all donations and complies with data protection requirements.
